Dear Mr. Myers:

Please be advised that pursuant to Section 42 of the Code of Student Rights, Responsibilities and Conduct, Interim Suspension, (Section 42, page 20 of the 2012-2013 Student Handbook), **you are hereby suspended from attendance at the State University of New York College at Oswego**, pending a hearing regarding the alleged charges which are outlined on the attached Statement of Charges.

**This Interim Suspension is effective as of 6:00 pm on Friday, October 19, 2012. You must remove your belongings and move out of Hart Hall no later than 6:00 pm on Friday, October 19, 2012.**


Further, **you are hereby advised that pending the outcome of a judicial hearing regarding the alleged charges as attached and until such time as the Interim Suspension is no longer in effect, you are not to enter the grounds or facilities of this campus without the specific permission of the Associate Vice President and Dean for Student Affairs (Dr. James F. Scharfenberger, 711 Culkin Hall, 312-3214).** Should you enter the campus grounds or facilities without such permission, you may be subject to arrest. You may also wish to contact your professors and advise them of your Interim Suspension.

A disciplinary hearing on the attached Statement of Charges will be scheduled by the Office of Judicial Affairs. Please review the enclosed documents. **You are required to contact the Office of Judicial Affairs, 501 Culkin Hall, 312-3378, no later than Monday, October 22, 2012, to discuss judicial procedures and confirm your new contact information: local address and telephone number.**

You may contact the Office of the Associate Vice President and Dean for Student Affairs for the purpose of scheduling a preliminary meeting with respect to the basis of my decision to invoke this Interim Suspension. Please call 312-3214 to schedule an appointment.
