Per our practice at the University of Oregon complaints received in University Housing, where the deadline for resolution is after the end of the residence life contract, are reviewed for transfer to the Office of Student Conduct and Community Standards. Residence Life received a complaint regarding your reported behavior in or around Carson ██████████ on June 09, 2014 with the following incident description: Harassing comments yelled from ██████████ to fifth floor resident and girlfriend. You were sent a Notice of Allegation related to the documented behavior.

The purpose of this letter is to warn you that this behavior may be a violation of the [Student Conduct Code](#). However, I am choosing not to take action with this report at this time, but I am retaining the complaint and this letter for the University's reference.
