To Whom It May Concern:

The UNC Undergraduate Executive Branch appreciates your commitment to protecting the individual rights and voices of students as well as your initiative in fostering a discussion. The Vann Administration is devoted to advocating for the rights of students at UNC and have consistently upheld our duty to do so.

Executive Order No. 2, the subject of your remarks, applies solely to the Undergraduate Executive Branch and does not affect any other Registered Student Organization (RSO) at UNC. Enacting Executive Order No. 2 and controlling our financial affiliations is fully within the branch’s rights as a student organization. The viewpoint-neutral allocation of

funds to RSOs at UNC is not officiated by the Executive Branch and is not threatened by Executive Order No. 2.

Our position is firm and in accordance with the Code that governs the UNC student body and the law, and we encourage you to refer to our website for our original statements regarding this issue. Developing an understanding of these documents may help to clarify any confusion surrounding our Executive Order and prevent further spread of harmful misinformation in the future.
