## Capt. J.T. Simpson:

While working the front desk of Alpharetta City Hall 01.27.2022 at 2 Park Plz I was alerted by a citizen coming into the building that there was a w/m panhandling aggressively and yelling at people outside. I contacted the male and asked him to leave and advised him panhandling was not allowed in Alpharetta. The w/m folded up his sign and just walked away towards Market St. but returned approx. 5 min later. I was told again by another citizen (Dan Merkel) that there was a male yelling at people and panhandling on the front steps of City Hall. I again contacted the w/m told him he was not allowed to panhandle and needed to leave. He stated I had no authority to do so. I told him panhandling is illegal in Alpharetta and he stated he wasn't panhandling. He stated I had no authority to make him leave, and I then requested his identification. He refused and pulled out two kids alphabet letters from his hoodie pocket and stated this is my I.D. I again requested his I.D. which he showed me his license but covered it with his hand and refused to give it to me. I asked him to have a seat until this issue was resolved and he refused. He became increasingly frustrated and began to walk away while I was still investigating this incident He was detained in handcuffs without incident until another officer arrived. identified as Jeffrey Gray from his FL driver's license. Gray stated he asked no one for money and wanted to only speak about homeless veterans. Gray was offered a ride and was asked if he needed any help and he refused both offers. Gray agreed to leave and was issued a warning for panhandling and a Field Interview was completed.
