I do not agree to the Orders requested for the reasons stated in Respondent's motion to quash and special motion to strike and the declarations, evidence, and other documents submitted with this Response (which are incorporated by reference). Further:

- (1) This Court lacks personal jurisdiction over me.
- (2) The alleged conduct consists of expression protected by the First Amendment and California Constitution, and the Petitioner cannot establish by clear and convincing evidence otherwise.
- (3) Petitioner cannot establish by clear and convincing evidence that my conduct is devoid of legitimate purpose.
- (4) Under Section 230 of the Communications Decency Act, I am not responsible for others' online speech.
- (5) I have never been to California and have no plans to go to California, so a stay-away order is not necessary to prevent irreparable harm.
- (6) I have no intention to purposefully and intentionally contact Petitioner, so a no-contact order is not necessary to prevent irreparable harm.
- (7) Petitioner is attempting to impose a prior restraint on protected expression, and her request for an order prohibiting speech about her is contrary to the First Amendment. Further, because traditional tort actions provide the Petitioner with a means to address alleged harm to her reputation, an order prohibiting speech about her is not necessary to prevent irreparable harm.


