Advertisements for non-university sales or job listings will not be approved regardless of student organization sponsorship.

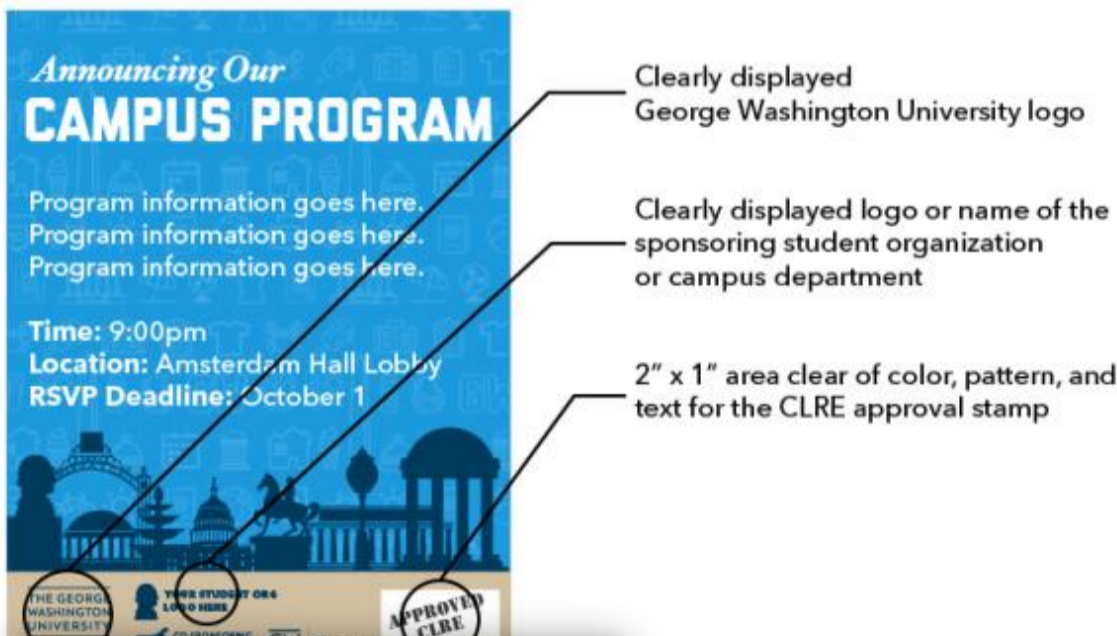
Posters in the Residence Halls

Poster Criteria

Posters must meet the following criteria:

- Be no larger than 8.5" by 11" in size
- Have an area 2 in. x 1 in. clear of color, pattern, and text for the CLRE approval stamp.
- Have a clearly-displayed George Washington University logo.
- Have a clearly-displayed logo or name of the sponsoring student organization or campus department.
- Student organizations and campus departments have a limit of one poster on the community board at any given time.
- Must be deemed appropriate under university policy and regulations.
- Must promote an event or program.
- Not be palm card size.
- Not be printed on orange paper, this color is reserved exclusively for emergency/GWPD notices.
- Not promote actions that are contrary to GW policy or display any form of harassment.
- Not promote alcohol consumption.

Please note: CLRE reserves the right to deny poster submissions based on safety concerns or appropriateness for display in community spaces.
